City Airport Expansion: Residents pack public meetings



At packed meetings in Leytonstone (above) and in Catford, organised by local MP Janet Daby (right), residents expressed shock at London City's expansion plans outlined in its draft Master Plan currently out for consultation until 20th September. The airport wants to almost double flight numbers from their current levels to 151,000 a year by 2035. It also wants to get rid of the ban on flights between midday Saturday and midday Sunday and to increase early morning and late evening flights.

Approaching 200 people crowded into the Leytonstone meeting organised by the Cann Hall Residents Association. The speakers included City Airport, HACAN East and local MP John Cryer. A lot of concern about noise, flight paths and climate change. In Catford, where Heathrow was also present, residents wanted Heathrow and London City to work together to coordinate flight paths.

Meetings to come: Waltham Forest Council will be holding a Public Meeting in Leytonstone Library on **10th September** 7.30- 9.30pm to. There will also be a Public Meeting in **Redbridge** in September, date to be confirmed

London City has said it will attend any meeting to which it is invited.
